

The Charter of Brooklyn Community Theatre (1999) Issue 4 17/10/08

This Charter defines the objectives and guidelines for the operation of Brooklyn Community Theatre.

Objective:

Brooklyn Community Theatre's mission is to provide the Community the opportunity to access and to participate in the production of live theatre performances.

Structure:

This Charter is administered by a panel of up to four persons. The Administrative Panel must include the Producer and Director. Other members may represent a Patron or the general community. The current Administrative Panel consists of the following persons:

- . Producer - Ray Bontoft
- . Director - Peter Hughes
- . Assistant Director. Gary Robertson

The Administrative Panel and Patron, if appointed, have the capability to disband BCT in the case of unresolved issues or the inability of the community at large to maintain the objectives and guidelines of this Charter.

Guidelines:

- . Brooklyn Community Theatre (BCT) is a non profit community based group with all roles carried out by volunteers.
- . Event selections are to be determined by the Administrative Panel.
- . Event content is to be 'family' oriented with an attempt to appeal to all ages.
- . Event types are primarily to be live theatre.
- . All events are to be conducted outdoors in picnic style.
- . Casting and crew positions are to be determined by the Administrative Panel and where possible positions are to be filled from within the community.
- . Where ever possible opportunity is to be given to young members of the community to participate.
- . Should reserve funds grow beyond the next events reserve budget the Administrative Panel, in concert with a Patron if appointed, can elect to make donations to the Patron and/or to other community service groups.
